As a certified social enterprise, you are now eligible to complete the Workforce Development, Aging Community Services (WDACS) Request for Statement of Qualifications (RFSQ) and be placed on an exclusive Master Agreement list. Take the following steps now:

## To apply, please follow the steps below and submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ):

STEP 1	Go to <a href="http://wdacs.lacounty.gov">http://wdacs.lacounty.gov</a> and click on "Business Opportunities with WDACS/Doing Business with WDACS"

STEP 3	<ul> <li>Gather the following documents as part of your SOQ:</li> <li>Certification by DCBA as a Social Enterprise</li> <li>At least one year of experience as a Social Enterprise</li> <li>Submission of financial statements per Addendum Three</li> <li>Complete the Required Forms in Appendix A of the RFSQ</li> </ul>

\*At the County's discretion the submission of less than three years of financial information is allowable if the agency presents documentable special circumstances and at least one year of audited financial information.

WDACS will review the SOQ, determine if it meets the qualifications and that acceptable documentation was provided to enter into a Master Agreement with the Social Enterprise.

## The Master Agreement with the County does not include any funding or Work Orders.

All County Departments may issue Social Enterprise Work Orders that utilize the Master Agreement list. Only participating Social Enterprises that have entered into the Social Enterprise Master Agreement may participate and compete in bidding/proposing for County-issued Social Enterprise Work Orders. Social Enterprises will be awarded funding based on the nature of the Work Order. Individual Work Orders will have applicable Mandatory Minimum Qualifications and the additional requirements of the Work Order.
