## **YOUR HOME IS SOMEONE'S WORKPLACE: DOMESTIC WORK IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY**

LOS ANGELES - On Friday, December 10, 2021, the Los Angeles County Office of Immigrant Affairs, in the Department of Consumer and Business Affairs, - in partnership with [California Domestic Workers Coalition](#) and [Hand in Hand: The Domestic Employers Network](#) - will host an ethnic media forum on the domestic work industry in Los Angeles County.
