### Item 3: Approval of Consumer Affairs Advisory Commission (CAAC) Minutes

Commissioner Leon moved to approve the minutes of the CAAC meeting for February 17, 2022. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ostroy. Motion to approve was passed unanimously via roll call vote.

### Item 4: Commissioner Welcome and Introduction – Carlos Collard, 2<sup>nd</sup> District

Newly appointed Commissioner Carlos Collard, 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District, provided a brief introduction and was welcomed to the CAAC by the Commission.

## Item 5: Assembly Bill 361 – Updated Information – Masking Mandate in County Facilities

Francisco Mendez, Department of Consumer and Business Affairs (DCBA) Commission Services Liaison, shared that the indoor masking mandate for Los Angeles County facilities will end on March 21, 2022. Masks are now strongly recommended, but not required, and will also be available at DCBA worksites and public counters for any individual upon request.

### Item 6: 2022 Commission Goals

Francisco Mendez shared the 2021 Commission Goals. After review and discussion, Commissioner Ostroy moved that the goals for 2021, with no changes or revisions made, be applied for 2022. Commissioner Jayne seconded the motion. Motion to approve was passed unanimously via roll call vote.

Commissioners from the 4<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District were unable to provide the Commissioner Report. ### Item 10: DCBA Department Update

Maggie Becerra, DCBA Deputy Director of Consumer Counseling, shared how the Department has been responding to complaints of price gouging for at home test kits for COVID-19 and on complaints received by consumers on purchases made for individually packed at home test kits. After an investigation was conducted by the Department, it was made evident that some businesses were separating testing kits and selling tests individually at a higher cost. Information on the investigation will be provided during a future Department update.
